Albuquerque has dozens of public pickleball courts for everyone's enjoyment.

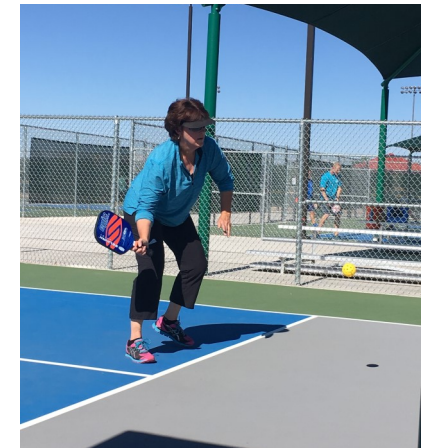
Our warm weather makes Albuquerque an ideal place for a game of singles or doubles!
